2050

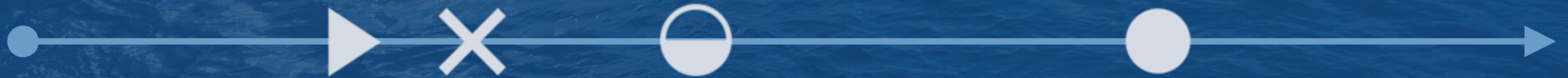
All commitments will be fulfilled, achieving lasting impact on global water security.

The WRC Member Commitment

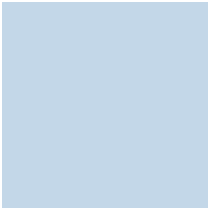
Achieving Positive Water Impact (PWI) requires three key actions:

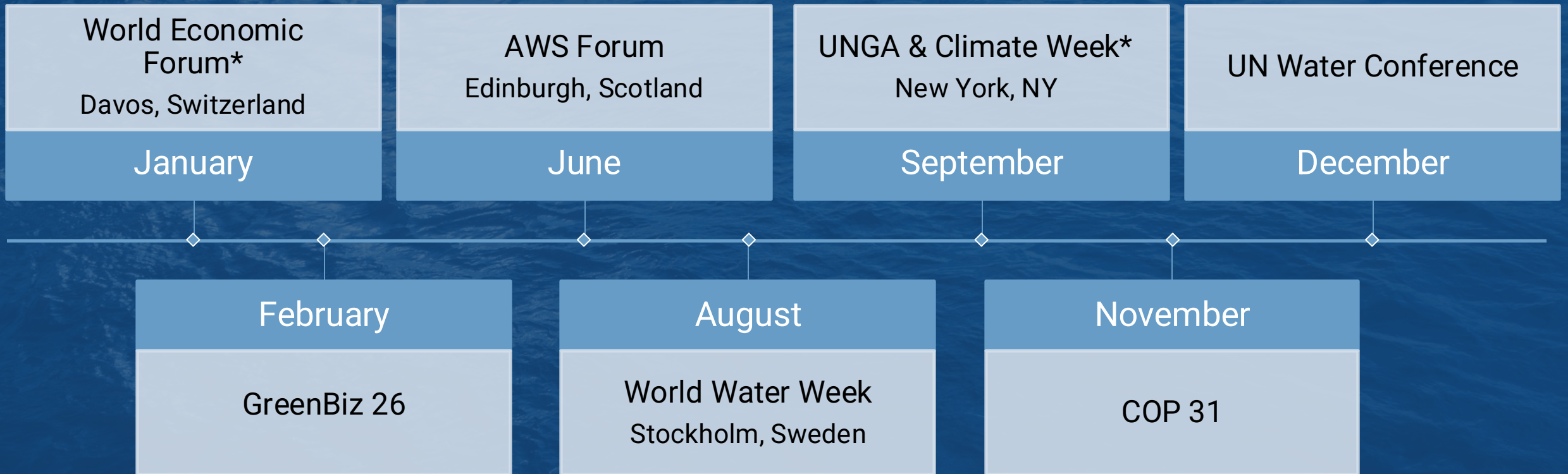
